

Recovery Funds Available to Weatherize Large Multifamily Buildings

Make the apartments in your building among the thousands weatherized through this new energy program.

Owners of residential multifamily buildings are encouraged to apply to the Wisconsin Department of Administration for the new Wisconsin Multifamily Weatherization Recovery Project.

Your building qualifies if it meets the following:

- Twenty or more units in one structure
- Two-thirds of the tenants have an income at 60% of the state median income

Buildings could receive heating system replacement, insulation and other energy saving improvements at no direct cost to the property owner.

Apply by August 26, 2009 to be considered for the first round of awards. Applications received by July 31 will be considered for the pilot awards. Additional application rounds are anticipated.



The State of Wisconsin has a strong commitment to weatherizing homes for low-income families. Now with funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act the state will increase that commitment and provide services to families living in apartment buildings, helping them lower their energy bills while creating local jobs.

The new program is run by the Department of Administration where there is extensive expertise in weatherization and contracting with local construction firms for state building projects.
